NTCC Kids Discovery College is hosting a fun, interactive and educational first responder academy. During the eight day academy, middle and high school students will learn from professionals who work and train as first responders in our community.

Students will learn about and participate in activities related to:

- **EMS Operations:** emergency scene scenarios, vital signs, CPR, Stop the Bleed (a national awareness campaign)
- **Police Operations:** Fingerprints, Intro to crime scene investigations, police dogs (K-9), self-defense, gun safety, cyber bullying/internet safety,
- **Fire Operations:** Fire extinguisher safety and training, firework safety scenarios, smoke ventilation, emergency rescue
