FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Immigration regulations require nonimmigrant international students to verify that they will have funds available to pay for all educational, living and other expenses. Students are reminded that the total tuition for one semester is to be wired to the college prior to arrival in the U.S. or NTCC. (Instructions will be sent once you let NTCC know you have received your F-1 Visa.)

3. If I remain in the U.S. during the summer, I will have a minimum of \$4,000 in United States currency available.

5. I can make the arrangements to have the necessary funds transferred to the United States and available to me prior to registration each semester. A bank account is necessary, since there is a charge for each use of a credit card.
6. I understand that regulations prohibit me from working to make extra money for my college expenses.
