### **Additional guide tips:**

The three semester schedule is to be utilized as a guide in selecting your semester course loads. Not all ag classes are offered every semester.

Ag students following certificate plan should select ag courses for the year to ensure they have the opportunity to take their preferred specialty courses when offered.

Minimum 41 credit hours required = listed required courses and AG elective courses to complete this certificate. Students may transition to applied associates in sustainable ag in adding core classes.

All first semester ag degree or certificate majors are required to meet with Ag faculty prior to 12th class day of their first semester for advisement.

AGRI courses are guaranteed transfer courses and other elective type courses are transferred dependent on the university granting transfer.
