PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

In the evolving healthcare environment, organizations need individuals who can plan, direct, and coordinate medical and health services. Healthcare managers work in a variety of organizational settings including hospitals, physician clinics, long-term care facilities, home health organizations, and others. The Healthcare Management program is designed to prepare students to work as entry-level managers in both business and healthcare settings. This curriculum is designed to prepare the student for entry-level positions in Healthcare Management and consists of both business and healthcare courses.

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JOB OUTLOOK

The job outlook for healthcare managers is good, with job growth at 17% from 2014-2024. The annual salary for associate degree healthcare managers ranges between \$30,000 - \$40,000, depending upon location and years of experience (Bureau of Labor Statistics). Once a student has earned their AAS in Healthcare Management, they may continue along the educational path to bachelors, masters, and doctorate degrees in Healthcare Management and Administration.
