\$244,730 RAISED ON EAST TEXAS GIVING DAY

The Northeast Texas Community College Foundation finished East Texas Giving Day at the top of the leader board for the second year in a row on April 25, 2023. NTCC raised a whopping \$244,730 via the annual fundraising event that has become a regional tradition.

In addition to raising the most money, NTCC also finished with the highest number of donations at 208. Nita May, NTCC Director of Development and event organizer, said that these numbers reflect the enthusiasm and effort put forth by NTCC employees, students and community members.

"Our employees and student organizations got involved in East Texas Giving Day early on and we ended up having the highest amount of money raised through individual celebration pages. Our students and employees are passionate about NTCC and that really shined through in their fundraising efforts," May said.



East Texas Giving Day is an 18-hour online event that provides critical funding for our area nonprofits. East Texas Communities Foundation partners with area nonprofits to give donors across East Texas a chance to raise funds for local needs. The purpose of an area-wide Giving Day is to bring the region together on one day and as one community, raising money and awareness for East Texas nonprofits. This initiative, organized by East Texas Communities Foundation (ETCF), provides citizens across ETCF's 32-county service area an easy platform to support the mission of local nonprofits that serve our communities.

"We are so thankful for the East Texas Communities Foundation for hosting this wonderful event. It has become our primary annual fundraiser and a source of fun and excitement on campus," May said.

From scholarships to livestock feed for the college farm, each dollar raised will go directly to support important causes at NTCC.

"We can't say thank you enough to everyone who gave to the NTCC Foundation. I am just blown away by the generosity," May said.

Distinguished Benefactor 2023 Greater Texas Foundation

he Northeast Texas Community College Foundation is excited to announce that the Greater Texas Foundation (GTF) has been named its Distinguished Benefactor for 2023. Since 2018, GTF has funded more than \$800,000 in projects for NTCC - including the Work4College Program and the Texas Emergency Aid Grant. Both of these initiatives have directly impacted the lives of many NTCC students.

"We are so thankful for the support of the Greater Texas Foundation. They have been integral to the growth of the Work-4College Program and remain a valued partner," Dr. Jonathan McCullough, NTCC Executive Vice President for Advancement, said.

GTF works with educational institutions, nonprofit organizations, and governmental agencies that share their vision of a state where all students have equal opportunity to access and succeed in postsecondary education. One of their specific priorities revolves around helping rural communities.

"Rural access has always been at the heart of what Greater Texas Foundation is about. Projects tend to move faster and have

less red tape in rural communities, which means you see results much sooner. NTCC's Work4College program is a great example of that," Sue McMillin, President and CEO of GTF said.

Thanks to GTF funding, the Work4College Program now has a full-time director, has expanded into multiple school districts and continues to grow each year.

NTCC was also named one of 10 community colleges that received the Texas Emergency Aid grant (pictured above) in

2021. This grant provided funding to help students facing difficulties with postsecondary completion after COVID-19. In addition to monetary support, GTF also provided institutions with training and technical support from a consultant to help make the program sustainable.

"NTCC has done a really awesome job starting the emergency aid program from scratch, having good outcomes. and refining the program based on the data," GTF Leslie Gurrola, Director of Programs and Strategy, said.

Nita May, NTCC Director of Development, led NTCC's emergency aid grant team. She said she has seen first-hand how the

funds are impacting individual students. "It is not uncommon for NTCC to have students drop out of college because they can't afford a textbook or a tank of gas. Having an emergency aid fund that gives us the flexibility to help them in these unforeseen circumstances is so important," May said. "GTF is a wonderful partner and we are very grateful for them."

Both NTCC and GTF have similar missions at their core: they want to help students succeed.

"At the end of the day, it is the students who really matter. The Greater Texas Foundation is doing outstanding work throughout the state and we are thrilled to have the chance to honor them as our newest Distinguished Benefactor," Mc-Cullough said.

Since 2024 will be the 10th year anniversary of the Work4College Program, we wanted to catchup with a member of the inaugural class of 2014. Caitlyn Froneberger was one of the 15 original students who helped pilot the Work4Col-

lege Program. During her time, she worked on the agricultural farm doing many different projects, from lancing abscesses on cattle to canning jars of pickles for the local farmer's market.

After graduating from Chapel Hill High School, she began her undergraduate degree at Tarleton State University. With the help of summer courses and the Work4College Program, Caitlyn was able to graduate from Tarleton in three years with her Bachelor of Science degree in Agricultural Services and Development.

She then went on to earn her Master of Science degree in Agricultural Sciences with a teaching certificate. Her professional career has consisted of two years as an agricultural science teacher, one year as a program technician for the Farm Service Agency, and now teaching 5th grade science lab at Sulphur Springs Elementary School.

"My most memorable opportunities include food preservation, best cattle handling practices, and greenhouse management. Every day was an adventure in the Work4College Program," Froneberger said.

Many of the skills she learned from the program have helped her in her career and even helped build her resume.

"Not only does it help fund your college career, but it also helps build work ethic, responsibility, and relationships you cannot find anywhere else," she said.







In the heart of Northeast Texas Community College (NTCC), one family's story unfolds. Dr. Doug Richey, a cherished Math professor at NTCC since its inception in July 1985, has sowed the seeds of higher learning within his own family. With a BS, MS, and Ph.D. from Commerce, and an extensive teaching background in eight different school systems, Dr. Richey is a pillar of the NTCC community.

But the story doesn't end with Dr. Richey. His three children got their start at NTCC. His daughter, Katrina Duplechain, who's taken the medical world by storm, graduated from NTCC in 1994 and went on to earn a BA in Chemistry from Baylor University, an MS in Biology at Texas A&M - Commerce, and an MD from the University of Texas Medical School in Houston. She is now at Christus Trinity Mother Frances. Katrina attributes her discipline and focus to Dr. Seabourne's NTCC karate class and advises incoming NTCC students to forge connections with dedicated instructors and prioritize exercise. She also credits retired NTCC faculty members, Dr. Jim Archer and Dr. Mary Hearron, for their guidance in science and math.

Similar to his father, education is in his blood, as Dr. James Douglas Richey, Jr. is now the Dean of Humanities, Communications and Fine Arts at Tyler Junior College. His 1990 NTCC Associate's proudly hangs on his wall with his Bachelor of Arts, Master's in English, and Ph.D. in Education from Texas A&M University-Commerce. His passion for learning is clear in his advice: "Treat your classes like a job you do not want to lose." He cherishes his time at NTCC and attributes his success to two esteemed professors, Dr. Larry Thompson and Dr. Ron Cowan. They inspired him to become an English major and later an English professor.

Lastly, Kendra Victoria Richey Miller, a 1996 NTCC graduate, has dedicated 16 years to Barrow Hanley Global Investors and now serves as a Senior Portfolio Administrator in the Fixed Income division. With an MS in Human Relations and Business from Amberton University and a BS in Speech Communica-


As a symbol of the Richey family commitment to NTCC, Dr. Doug and Kathy Richey plan to establish a scholarship at the college in the names of their children.


"Education has played an important role in our family and we want to pass that gift on to others," Dr. Doug Richey, Sr. said.



Most scholarships are established through the NTCC Foundation and awarded annually by the scholarship committee. There are three types of NTCC Foundation scholarships: annual, perpetual and endowed.

Annual Scholarship (\$500 minimum): To establish an AN-NUAL scholarship you must have a minimum of \$500. This named scholarship can be good for one year or renewed annually.

Perpetual Scholarship (\$10,000 minimum): To establish a PERPETUAL scholarship a person/business must have a minimum of \$10,000. The funds received from the earnings on

the investment will be awarded to offset the cost of tuition, fees, and/or books. This named scholarship will remain in effect as long as the College continues to exist.

Endowed Scholarship (\$25,000 minimum): To establish an ENDOWED scholarship a person/business must have a minimum of \$25,000. The funds received from the earnings on the investment will be used to pay toward a full scholarship (tuition, fees, and books) for one student each year. This named scholarship will remain in effect as long as the College exists.

The donor, along with the assistance of the College, will establish the scholarship criteria. **Please contact the NTCC Development Office at 903-434-8113** for an appointment to establish your scholarship. In addition to the general scholarship fund, all annual, perpetual and endowed scholarships will accept contributions at any time. ()
