Our College fully supports the Texas Association of Community Colleges (TACC) Formula Funding Request (per letter dated August 16, 2024).

Northeast Texas Community College respectfully requests the legislature to fully fund a supplemental amount equal to the increase over appropriated Fiscal Year 2025 formula appropriation amounts using the rates and weights set by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and the dynamic payments amount that provides funding to recognize high performing institutions that are achieving outcomes above the level forecasted for them. The combination of strong performance trends and goal-oriented funding rates creates a total performance funding yield of approximately \$1.12 billion for FY25, which puts biennial program expenses about \$40 million over the FY24-25 appropriation; this is the current supplemental funding need.

Additionally, colleges respectfully request the full amount of formula funding for FY26 and FY27 based on the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's forecast of performance by colleges and continuing the Board adopted weights and rates. Funding at these levels provides certainty for colleges who are pivoting to align around the incentives for student achievements in earning credentials of value, including those in short term workforce credentials, dual credit attainment, and transfer. This ensures colleges are focused on the workforce needs and educational requirements that the state has requested in House Bill 8.

With continued support from the state of Texas, Northeast Texas community College will:

• Increase short-term, micro-credential programs, such as cyber-security, logistics, truck driving and other high demand job training programs beneficial to the economic growth of the region.

• Continue to expand our award-winning CTE/Dual Credit center in Mt Pleasant to support regional workforce programs vital to our local economy.

• Increase the number of high-demand health science dual credit programs to include more of our rural area ISD's.

• Fund additional student support personnel and career counseling staff in support of the Texas "Guided Pathways" project to improve high school -to-community college and four-year college transfer and completion rates.

• Further expand our innovative work scholarship program, which provides students with meaningful work at above-market wages, and allows them to complete a community college degree without student loan debt. This program is uniquely designed to address the cost of attendance while also preparing "work-ready" students who will have a valuable work history to add to their educational credentials upon graduation.

• Continue support for an Early College High School in collaboration with an area ISD to provide additional dual credit opportunities for low income/first generation students.

• Provide reskilling/upskilling training opportunities for local workforce.

### SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN POLICY:

There are no significant changes in policy which impact this budget.

### SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN PROVISION OF SERVICE:

There are no significant changes in provision of service which impact this budget.

### SIGNIFICANT EXTERNALITIES:

Growing inflation has had a dramatic and adverse impact on NTCC's ongoing operations, our students, and the community we serve. NTCC's service region has also

experienced major losses to its tax base due to the closing of the area's coal mining operations, a major coal-fired power plant, and U.S. Steel plant.

#### ORGANIZATION OF COLLEGE


