Description: The Cooperative business in agriculture course is best described as an internship course in which students will attain hands-on experiences while working for an agricultural related company. The student must complete the **5-10** week program working an average of 15-20 hours per week for the company in order to receive credit for the course. Each company must be approved by the director before signing up for the course.

The student will be required to complete an assessment prior to beginning the course and one at the end of the course. The company will be required to verify employment and notify the school should the student no longer be employed.
